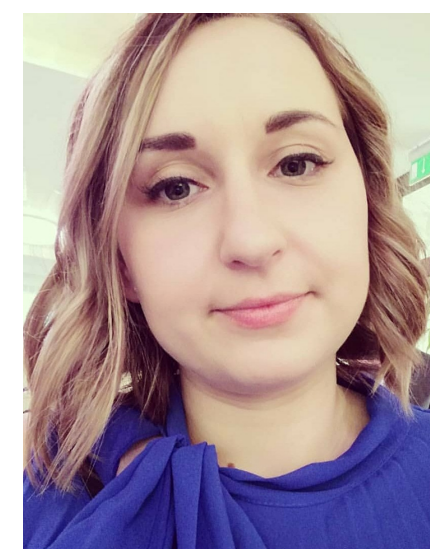


Iwona Woch
